Take the tours outside Tirana, and enjoy nature

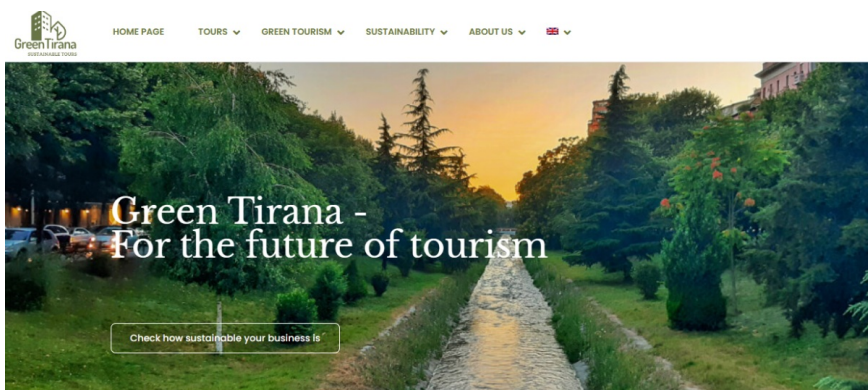
